**RESOLUTION #:** 6

**TITLE:** Kamchatka-Alaska Project

**WHEREAS:** Among the important issues raised at the 8th WWC was conservation in the Russian Far East, specifically in Kamchatka. A Kamchatka-Alaska roundtable took place on October 2 in Alaska at Campbell Creek in which delegates from Kamchatka, representatives of Alaskan nature conservation agencies, representatives from other US states and other countries participated. A list of proposals on development of a partnership co-operation between Alaska and Kamchatka protected areas was worked out and supported by all participants.

**THEREFORE:** Parties to those proposals would like to see them implemented.

**RESOLVED:** The 8<sup>th</sup> World Wilderness Congress urges development and implementation of a Kamchatka-Alaska Partnership for Protected Areas by the UNDP/GEF.
